Mental Health Data Dashboard Release!

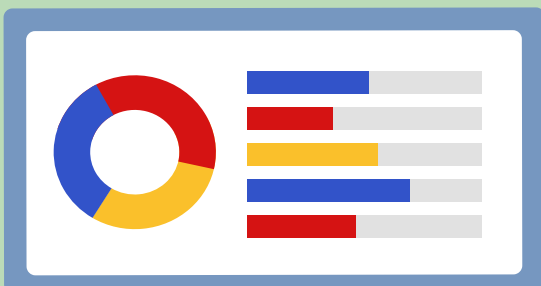
Schools that took part in Age of Wonder last year now have access to their mental health and wellbeing data!

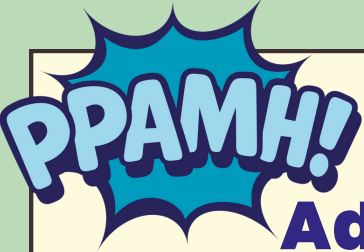
