#### **Clean Air Zone (CAZ)**

Now we want to ask you about Bradford Councils Plans to reduce pollution in the city, also known as Breathe Better Bradford.

Along with other cities with high levels of pollution, Bradford has implemented a 'Clean Air Zone' in the city where older polluting buses, coaches, taxis, heavy goods vehicles and light goods vehicles that enter parts of the city are charged. Diesel vehicles need to be Euro 6 emission standard (e.g. built in 2015 or later) and Petrol Euro 4 emission standard (e.g built in 2005 or later) as a minimum to avoid a daily charge. Daily charges are £50 for heavy goods vehicles, coaches and buses, £7 for taxis and £9 for light goods vehicles and minibuses. The council have offered a range of incentives to help taxi and transport operators upgrade to cleaner hybrid or electric vehicles along with other initiatives to improve air quality. Private vehicles (e.g. cars and motorcycles) are exempt from the Clean Air Zone charges.

The map below shows the charging areas for the Breathe Better Bradford Clean Air Zone. This includes all areas of Bradford which currently exceed legal limits of pollution.
