Why is this study being done?

Pollution in our city is very high and is harming the health of our children and young people. Bradford Council have been asked by the UK Government to develop plans to improve air quality within the city, including implementing a 'clean air zone'. Born in Bradford want to find out what you think about Bradford council's plans, and the best ways to reduce pollution to help keep families healthy and happy. We plan to carry out a survey with lots of people across the city to get an understanding of their views. We will use this information to find out the most important things that could be done in the city to reduce pollution in Bradford and elsewhere.

Why have I been asked to take part in this study?

We are asking BiB families who live or regularly visit parts of Bradford where there are high levels of pollution to take part.



Do I have to take part?

No. It is up to you. Even if you say yes now, you can change your mind at any time without giving any reason.



Are there any risks in participating?

There are no known risks for you to worry about with taking part in this study.



Will my taking part in the study be kept private?

Yes. If you decide to participate in this research project, the research data collected from you will be kept strictly confidential in accordance with the consent that you have given, and also the Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) 2018. All your personal information (name, address and telephone number) will be kept private and stored safely by Born in Bradford.

At the end of the study, your information will be securely saved for 20 years as part of the BiB cohort. Born in Bradford is a part of the Bradford Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust.



What will happen to the results of the research study?

We will share our findings with communities across Bradford, with health professionals and other researchers. We also hope to publish the results in an academic journal, which is where scientists present their findings.
